ARROW SOFT WHEAT

Arrow is an AGSECO soft red winter wheat variety released in 2010. It is best adapted to the eastern 1/3 of Kansas, northeast Oklahoma, and southwest Missouri. Arrow offers producers consistently good performance, heavy test weight, and the best scab tolerance commercially available. Arrow has excellent tolerance to Head Scab, Powdery Mildew, and Stripe Rust and is moderately resistant to leaf rust and soil borne mosaic virus. It has good straw strength and is an excellent selection to plant after corn or soybeans.
