WB CEDAR WHEAT

Cedar is a hard red winter wheat variety developed by WestBred and released to AGSECO in 2011. It is adapted to all of Kansas, Oklahoma and southern Nebraska. Cedar offers producers consistently good performance, heavy test weight, and very good tolerance to acid soils. Cedar is resistant powdery mildew, and intermediate on Septoria leaf blotch and tan spot. It has excellent straw strength and is early in maturity. Cedar's performance has been outstanding in yield trials and it has an opportunity to become a dominate variety in Kansas and Oklahoma.
