FULLER WHEAT

Fuller is a hard red winter wheat variety released by Kansas State University in 2006. This variety is most similar to Overley. However, when compared to Overley, Fuller resists shattering better and has a different source of resistance to Leaf Rust. Fuller is rated intermediate on acid soil tolerance (slightly less tolerant than Overley). Performance of Fuller has been outstanding in the eastern 2/3 of Kansas.
